# FOOD BRINGS HOPE

## Former principal takes reins at nonprofit

A longtime elementary school principal is the new executive director of Food Brings Hope, a local charity that provides food and recreational activities to children in need. Judi Winch, who recently retired from Westside Elementary School, started the job on Sept. 1 and said she's excited for the new opportunity.

"I want to do everything to the best of my ability," she said by phone Wednesday. "I want to visit the schools and learn what the needs are at each school. I just know there are a lot of impoverished children and we do need to help them."

Winch said in a statement that her mission as an educator has always been

to help children of poverty achieve and succeed, and that she's had a difficult time accepting an end to that chapter of her life.

"It has been said that as one chapter of your life ends, another is just beginning," she said. "As the executive director, the position gives me the opportunity to touch

the lives of children in 14 schools with the desire to expand this initiative to other schools in Volusia County and beyond."

Winch's role will be to develop the nonprofit's growing roster of partnered schools and initiatives. She will also meet with current and future Food Brings Hope partnered schools to map out their plans for success for their after-school programs.

Forough Hosseini, Food Brings Hope founder and chair, said Winch was offered the job because of her proven record as an outstanding principal.

"She has our full support in carrying out FBH's mission of nurturing the mind, body and spirit of underprivileged children in our community," Hosseini said.
