




Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University hosts Food Brings Hope Pep Rally

At Food Brings Hope, we continue to be touched by the generosity of organizations and individuals in our community who share our goal to eliminate hunger among our school children. One such partner is Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, which launched its "\$7 sacrifice" campaign designed to generate \$25,000 for Food Brings Hope's weekend grocery bag program.

Teams include: Athletes, the individual colleges (College of Arts and Sciences, College of Aviation, College of Business, College of Engineering), Enrollment/Admissions, Student Government Association/Student Team, Student Affairs, University Administration, Worldwide Headquarters and on their own team Embry-Riddle President John Johnson, Ph.D. and his wife Maurie Johnson.



"This isn't the first time Embry-Riddle has stepped up to the plate for the community," says Forough B Hosseini, Founder and Chairman of Food Brings Hope, who along with her husband Mori, are both Embry-Riddle alumni. "For several years now, the university has been an active supporter of Food Brings Hope's efforts.
